You can access government funding of \$1250 every year, for practical support to help you reach your goals and additional funding for immediate support.

Our flexible and mobile servicing makes our mentors available to you when you need them.

Who Is It For?

Parents and carers who have a child under 6 and receive either a parenting, carer or special benefit payment.

OR

Not in receipt of an income support payment but are under 22 years old, a First Nations parent or carer or an early school leaver.

How does it work?

Contact National Joblink to register your interest and we will connect you with an experienced and passionate mentor who will give you individualised and tailored support.

Your mentor will work with you to create a tailored, achievable goal plan that considers your important role as a parent/carer and sets you up for future success.
